TWO DAY TELEVISION-LECTURE COURSE IN ENDODONTICS

A television-lecture course, "Endodontic Treatment of Single and Multi-Rooted Teeth," will be presented October 27 and 28, 1965 at Temple University School of Dentistry, Philadelphia, Pa., by Dr. Leonard Parris, Professor of Endodontics.

During this intensive two-day course, endodontic procedures will be presented in a logical treatment sequence, from a clinical point-of-view. Kodachrome slides, radiographs, charts, and diagrams will be used to illustrate the lectures. Immediately following each lecture session, the endodontic procedure discussed will be demonstrated over closed-circuit television. Large-screen monitors will insure intimate viewing for all participants. Question and answer periods will be scheduled throughout the course. A booklet outlining endodontic procedures demonstrated and detailing the instruments and equipment used will be available for each participant.

SURGICAL ENDODONTICS PARTICIPATION COURSE AT TEMPLE

A participation course in "Immediate Surgical Endodontics" will be presented at Temple University School of Dentistry on March 21-25, 1966, under the direction of Dr. Leonard Parris.

On Monday and Tuesday, closed-circuit television will be used for the clinical demonstrations of various surgical endodontic procedures. Starting Tuesday afternoon and continuing the remainder of the week, the postgraduate students will perform surgical endodontic procedures on clinic patients under close supervision of the teaching staff. Posterior endodontic surgery will be included and the various techniques of hemisection. At the end of each clinic day, all cases treated that day will be discussed by all participants. Enrollment is limited.
